<b>Meeting Notes</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Miss Bertham shared actions and information from last meeting<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Shared the anti-bullying week programme – we have had a visiting theatre show for Key Stage 2. Our justice council have taken part in an assembly.</li><li>▪ Shared the research conducted into KS2 homework model we will be trialling a new system for Yr 2 and 6 in term 3.</li></ul></li><li>• Stay and read was enjoyed by lots. In Y4, due to acting workshop, some parents missed out on the opportunity to read with KS2 children and KS1. For our next session we will text parents to let them know that they need to go to the youngest child's classroom and we will send older siblings there for them all to read together.</li><li>• Miss Bertham shared the overarching targets in the School Development Plan and explained who the leaders of each team are. Parents were impressed with the number of objectives and the broad range of school developments that are taking place.</li><li>• Miss Bertham explained the benefit and power of working with other schools in the Nexus alliance. We have a strong partnership across the 7 Nexus schools and enjoy sharing best practise.</li></ul>	

- Questions raised on how the school is going to best address the lowest 20% of achievers as highlighted in the SDP.
  - Miss Bertham shared the role that quality first teaching has to play in the achievement for all children
  - We shared the role of Mrs Curtis, our Pupil Premium Champion and Mrs Emes, our school/home support worker in working closely with a wide range of children and families.
- Miss Bertham shared some of the ideas for the Forest Schools- AM explained. We are visiting other schools to get some ideas about what we could develop further at our school.
- Mrs O'Connor shared that the Master Classes are a fantastic opportunities for children to share their voices in a different format to the usual curriculum.
- Miss Bertham shared the format for this year nativity performances. (R, Y1&2 and KS2)
