Minutes of the last Meeting

- Numeracy and Literacy pages have been updated and both pages were shared with the parents present at the meeting. **ACTION:** email link (phonics video) to parents. **ACTION:** email link to Lit/Maths page to parents.
- Shared class pages – spelling for each year group have been added. Further updates, for example links to games are ongoing.
- Clubs page updated – Teacher clubs and Mr Gardiner’s clubs are on the website for the year. Teachers clubs can change throughout the year so it was pointed out that parents need to be aware of this and not take the Clubs yearly overview as set for the year.

Jobs Jamboree

- Last year, parents were invited in to share the job that they do and then provide the children with an activity linked to it. We are keen to run this again this year. The children really enjoyed it last year and were really involved. This year, parents would appreciate some support – provide a meeting before hand to discuss expectations and support parents with the kind of activities that the children can participate in– what skills, what training have you had. To support the parents who volunteer to run these sessions, it was agreed that the teacher would have a few questions to ask during the sessions and that these would be given to the parents beforehand. **ACTION:** teachers to formulate questions when they know what job the parent will be coming to talk about with the children.
- It was raised that some parents had a practical activity last year however some jobs didn’t lend itself to an activity which is fine.

Ofsted Parents View

- This is the first place Ofsted look at to see the parents' view of the school. As many parents as possible to go to this page and answer to questions.

Safe Parking Update

- Police are very concerned with the safety around the school and have been issuing fixed penalty notices.
- The Police are requesting that parents call 101/ email details to Avon and Somerset constabulary site – **Stanbridge is flagged as a priority.**
- Some parents have been trying to help by talking to people who are not parked safely or legally – some positive response however parents need to be aware this is not always the case.
- Drivers are mounting the pavement and driving along whilst parents and children are using it.
- Building work Woodall close is causing pedestrian issues – **ACTION:** Miss Bertham will write to the owners of the property raising the concerns.
- **ACTION:** Re-email N Usher to council details
- **ACTION:** school council to carry out a road safety survey around the school (Miss Morgan)

AOB:

- **ACTION:** text parents reminders about not bringing dogs on site.
- Charity support - Request that the Christmas boxes be on going every year. This really involved the children in understanding that not everyone can afford Christmas and lots of children do not receive anything at Christmas and the idea of giving and not just receiving at Christmas. Miss Bertham agreed this would continue.
- Homework – 2016-17 will be reviewed.
- 3 Peaks behaviour challenge – a positive reward to encourage children to achieve a variety of tasks. Each child has a little card with things that need to be achieved to receive a certificate for each peak (1-3). Some examples of the tasks are completing the expected homework for the term, showing our values (respect, uniqueness, pride curiosity, togetherness and creativity), receiving a good behaviour letter, Head

Teacher sticker, All Star certificate. This is flexible and teachers will be working with children who have additional needs and their parents (if necessary) to help them achieve the peak 1, 2 and 3.

- **ACTION:** re-explain the 3 Peaks challenge to parents in school newsletter.
- **Roles and responsibilities** – SDL/ House captains/ school council will be wearing coloured, labelled t-shirts or hoodies to raise the profile of the role. Peer mediators have applied by letter to Miss Bertham and will be chosen from the content of the letter.
- **Clubs – ACTION:** KS1 teachers need to create a list of children and the club they attend and the day they go so that if the main class teacher is not in another member of staff can ensure children go to the club at the end of the day.
- **Positive feedback:** KS1 parent has fed back really positive feedback about home/school support.
- **PTA events** are really well supported by parents and teachers and the children have really enjoyed recent events.
- **ACTION:** add to briefing to remind KS1 staff to be punctual at the start and end of the day with letting the children in and seeing them home.
- **KS1 nativity – Really positive feedback** - the changes that were put in place were brilliant. Everyone could be seen and had their moment within the show. **ACTION:** feedback to staff.
- **ACTION:** open purchasing of tickets for events – KS1 on a different day to KS2 - so that it is accessible and doesn't crash. Booking went really well and everyone was accommodated.
- **ACTION:** Mr Baker to carry out e-safety with Year 6 as there are issues with passing unpleasant chain mail which is very upsetting. Parents are very welcome to inform the school of issues as it will be followed up in school if it is effecting the child's welfare.
