Trips:

- The WWII trip was discussed with reference to the current year 4 cohort who will not be going on the trip. The question was raised as to whether the current year 4s could do the trip next year so they don't miss out. There is a day trip that gives a similar experience and the possible movement of the WWII topic to year 5.

Pick and Mix:

- Parents raised a concern over amount of homework in EYFS. The length of the term and the amount of homework required needs to be considered. Consider extra challenge for G&T children.
- Review of how the Pick and Mix is going – Parent Questionnaire.
- A request was made for support for EYFS parents with managing homework and strategies and approaches to homework. NEXT STEP : collate ideas at next PIP meeting.

Parental Involvement:

Ideas were shared for how the school can encourage greater parental involvement:

- Jobs Jamboree – parent have different slot to do a work shop linked to their job.
- Dad's Day – male role model day and family member (male) can come in to do a focussed session.

- Grandparents day – share old school games, memorabilia, school experiences.

Library

- Open after school on a Tuesday/Thursday (possible once per week) – parent librarian would enable it to be open from 3.20 until 4.20. Finishing time of Library slot to not coincide with end of clubs.
- NEXT STEP: speak to parents who sent in suggestion to ask if they would like to do it. Parent volunteer to man the signing in and out of people visiting the library.
- NEXT STEP: survey monkey/ text who would be interested in it being open after school.
- Possible library club – parent can come with children.

PTA

- Jobs day – summer holidays parents come in with children to help with a project (staining Gazebo, bunting around the school etc)
- Next meeting arrange a date and brainstorm ideas.
- NEXT Meeting – share the action plan for the Play Pod.

Inclusion

- Mr Williams shared how we use the data about children's progress and systems in place to identify learning needs for all children and how those needs will be met.
