Dear Parents/Carers of Year 4 children,

Year 4 Camping Under Canvas Experience- Final arrangements

We are writing to thank you for taking up this wonderful opportunity for your child and to confirm that this exciting 'camp out' experience is now only 11 sleeps away!

The camp out experience will take place on Monday 14th & Tuesday 15th May. Activities based around the class topic of 'Tribes' will take place during the school day, along with pitching of the tents and other bush craft activities. Children who are not camping out on Monday evening will still be able to be involved in all activities during the school day and will be collected at 3.20pm on Monday as usual. Parents/Carers will be invited to join us for a BBQ tea, please note will be from 5.30 onwards. BBQ food for the camping pupils will be FREE, but there will be a small charge for adults and other siblings. Please indicate below how many adults and siblings will be attending. After that, we say our goodbyes and the evening activities begin with games and a camp fire. It is imperative that no parents return to the camp unless there is an emergency. All contact details will be onsite and **ONLY** if necessary Miss Bertham will contact the parents direct. **All children will then need to be collected at 1.30pm on Tuesday 15th May** from their class room doors.

Please can all pupils arrive at school at the normal time of 8.45am and enter through the Year 4 classroom doors instead of the gym entrance. Children can wear non uniform clothes suitable for bush craft activities on both Monday & Tuesday. Please remember to bring a packed lunch for Monday's picnic lunch and breakfast snacks (fruit, cereal bars, juice) for Tuesday's breakfast. We will provide squash/water throughout the camp. **IMPORTANT INFORMATION If you require your child to have a school lunch on the Tuesday 15th, please book them a hot/cold meal through the Dolce catering service. If you DO NOT order a meal on that day, we will assume your child will be eating with you after collection at 1.30pm thank you.**

Miss Treharne, Mr Passmore, Miss Gough and I will be supervising the whole event and will work in partnership with Allnatt Tented Camps to make the event memorable and exciting for the children.

To make sure we have a safe and enjoyable event, we need to ensure all relevant information is obtained from you. Attached is a parental medical consent form which will need to be returned to the office by **Tuesday 8th May 2018**. Also attached is a camper's kit list for your guidance. **PLEASE NOTE NO MOBILE PHONES OR ELECTRICAL DEVICES TO BE BROUGHT ON THE CAMP.**
